- Schwerpunkt der ausgewerteten Zeitschriften im anglo-amerikanischen Raum

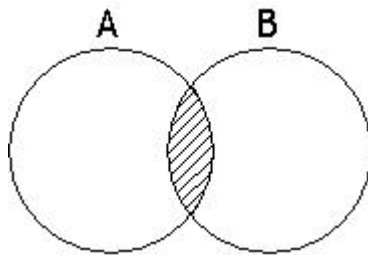

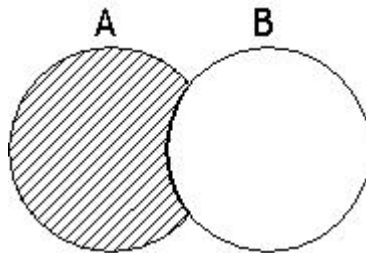

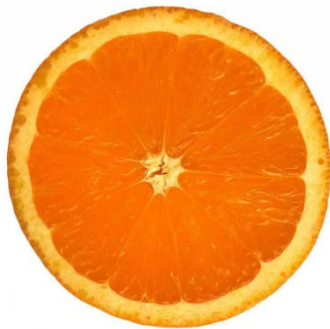

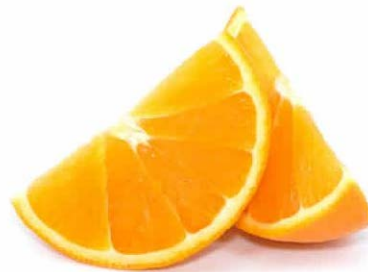

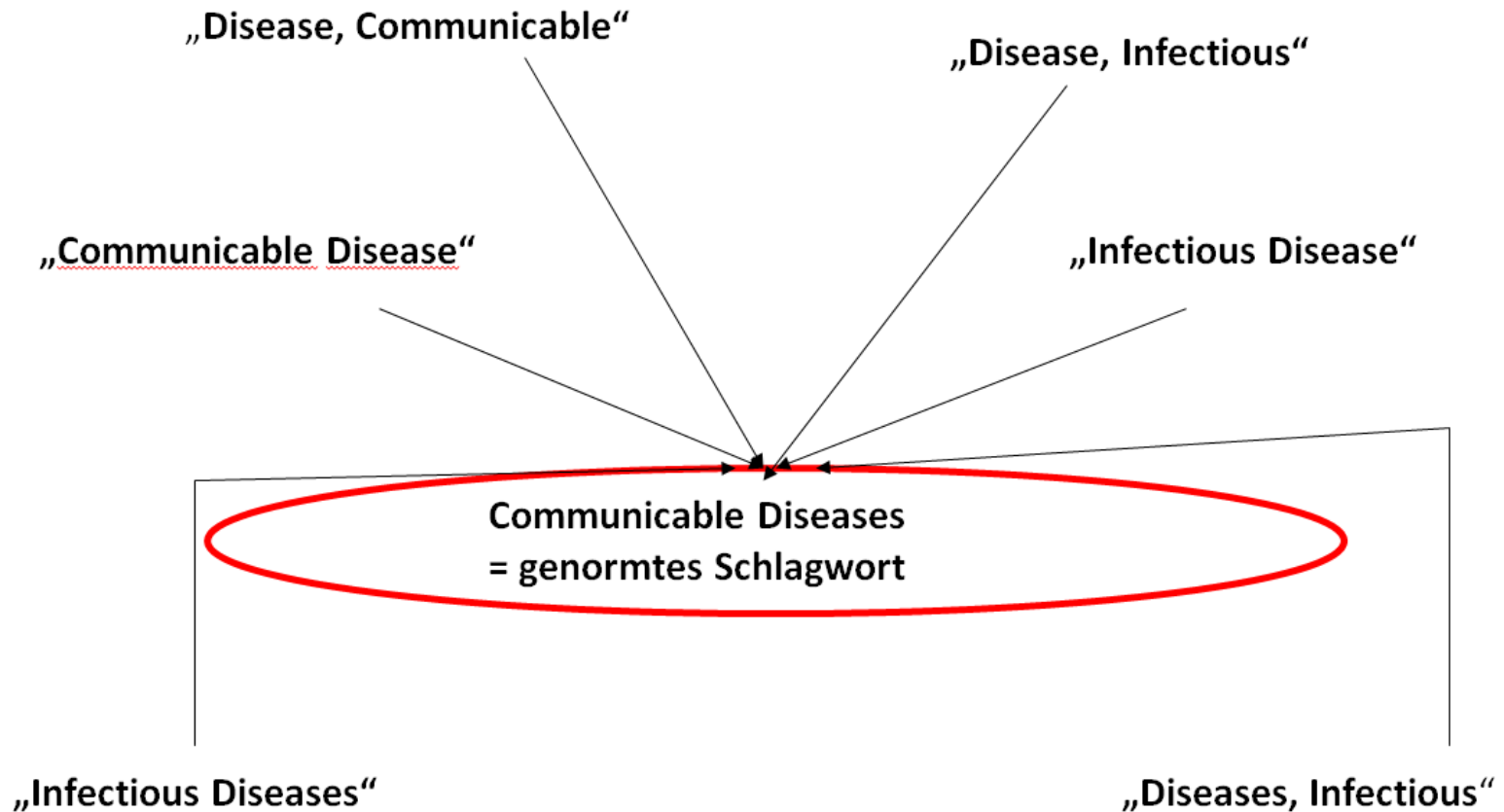
